











Boys' Dress Code

	<p>SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Solid color Oxford or other solid color long & short sleeve button front shirt with a collar
	<p>POLO SHIRTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Polo style knit shirt ▪ Long & short sleeve ▪ Any solid color. ▪ No Logos or emblems except PHCA
	<p>TURTLENECKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No mocks ▪ Any solid color
	<p><u>SWEATERS /</u> CARDIGANS / VESTS / PHCA SWEATSHIRT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Any solid color ▪ No contrasting trim ▪ Must be worn over in-code shirt or with turtleneck ▪ PHCA sweatshirts may be worn in place of sweaters
	
	<p>UNIFORM SLACKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Navy Blue, Black or Khaki only ▪ Dress style-twill or corduroy fabric only ▪ Pleated or plain front ▪ No outside patch pockets ▪ No rivets ▪ Belted or non-belted ▪ Plain, dark colored belts must be worn if slacks have belt loops
	
	<p>Shorts may be worn: August, September, May, and June only</p> <p><i>(Shorts may not be worn on Chapel days.)</i></p> <p>UNIFORM SHORTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Black, Navy Blue or Khaki only ▪ Knee-length walking shorts ▪ No outside patch pockets ▪ No rivets ▪ Plain dark colored belts must be worn if shorts have belt loops ▪ To the knee or no more than 2" above

	<p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dress or tennis shoes ▪ Tennis shoes with non-marking soles must be worn for PE classes ▪ Socks must cover the ankle ▪ Heels no more than 1/2" ▪ No open back shoes, sandals, or boots
	<p>SOCKS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Any solid color ▪ Must cover ankle
<p>CHAPEL DRESS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ White dress shirt with tie ▪ Uniform slacks only ▪ Grades K-2 may wear dark shoes or tennis shoes ▪ Grades 3-6 <i>must</i> wear dark dress shoes ▪ No PHCA sweatshirts 	
<p>JEANS DAY</p> <p>A special JEANS DAY may be announced at the end of each quarter. Students may wear Blue Jeans and a T-shirt or other shirt (using good discretion). No Sleeveless shirts.</p>	
<p>JEANS DAY CERTIFICATES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Throughout the year Jeans Certificates may be given out as various rewards. Blue Jeans may be worn in place of dress code pants. Dress code shirt must still be worn, tucked in, with a belt. ▪ In September and May only, Blue Jean Shorts may be used with a Jeans Pass. Jean Shorts must be hemmed (No Cutoffs) and in good condition (no more than 2" above the knee). 	
<p>OTHER STIPULATIONS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ HAIRSTYLES should be conservative and modest. Any hair style that demonstrates an extreme is inappropriate. Hair must be cut so that it is above the collar in back, above the eyebrows in front, and no longer than the earlobes on the sides. ▪ LOGOWEAR...Shirts with PHCA emblem may be worn. ▪ NO TAILS or PONYTAILS and NO EARRINGS ▪ P.E. Uniforms are Required for Grades 5 & 6 (Gym shirts are to be worn for gym only) <p>VIOLATION OF DRESS CODE: The student will be instructed to write the portion of the dress code in violation for the parent(s) to sign and return.</p>
